IN RE: HB112 by Smith, Wayne (Relating to compliance histories for and incentives to reward compliance performance by entities regulated by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would take effect November 1, 2003, assuming that it received the requisite two-thirds majority votes in both houses of the Legislature.
