1	AN ACT
2	relating to the composition of the Parks and Wildlife Commission.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 11.012(d), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(d) In making appointments under this section, the
7	governor:
8	<u>(1)</u> shall <u>:</u>
9	(A) attempt to include persons with expertise in
10	diverse fields, including fields such as historic preservation,
11	conservation, and outdoor recreation; and
12	(B) consider the commission's composition in
13	terms of:
14	(i) the geographical areas represented by
15	members of the commission; and
16	(ii) the appropriate balance of
17	representatives from rural and urban areas; and
18	(2) may include persons who have an interest in and
19	knowledge of hunting, fishing, wildlife, environmental concerns,
20	land or water use issues, or water quality issues.
21	SECTION 2. (a) As soon as possible on or after December 1,
22	2003, the governor shall appoint nine members to the Parks and
23	Wildlife Commission under Section 11.012, Parks and Wildlife Code,

as amended by this Act. The governor shall designate:

- 1 (1) three members, including one public member, for
- 2 terms expiring February 1, 2005;
- 3 (2) three members, including one public member, for
- 4 terms expiring February 1, 2007; and
- 5 (3) three members, including one public member, for
- 6 terms expiring February 1, 2009.
- 7 (b) The governor may reappoint a person who served as a
- 8 member of the Parks and Wildlife Commission before December 1,
- 9 2003.
- 10 (c) The position of a member of the Parks and Wildlife
- 11 Commission serving immediately before December 1, 2003, is
- 12 abolished at the time five or more of the newly appointed directors
- 13 qualify for office. Until the abolition of the members' positions
- 14 occurs under this section, the members serving immediately before
- 15 December 1, 2003, have the same powers and duties that the members
- 16 had immediately before that date and the commission continues to be
- 17 composed in the way it was composed before that date, and the former
- 18 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect December 1, 2003.
