1	AN ACT
2	relating to the eligibility of certain governmental retirees to
3	participate in certain group benefit plans.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1551.102, Insurance Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
7	(i) Subject to Section 1551.323, an individual is eligible
8	to participate in the group benefits program as an annuitant if the
9	individual:
Ω	(1) served in a position for which the individual was

- 10 (1) served in a position for which the individual was
 11 eligible to participate in the group benefits program under Section
- 12 <u>1551.101</u> on or before August 31, 2003; and
- 13 (2) at the time of retirement meets the requirements
- 14 for eligibility for participation in the program as an annuitant as
- those requirements existed on August 31, 2003.
- SECTION 2. Section 1551.111, Insurance Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- (e) An individual is eligible to participate in the group
- benefits program as an annuitant as described under this section if
- 20 the individual:
- 21 <u>(1) served as an officer or employee as described by</u>
- 22 Subsection (b)(1) on or before August 31, 2003; and
- 23 (2) at the time of retirement meets the requirements
- 24 for eligibility for participation in the program as an annuitant as

- 1 those requirements existed on August 31, 2003.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 1551.112, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 3 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 4 (c) An individual is eligible to participate in the group
- 5 benefits program as an annuitant as described under this section if
- 6 the individual:
- 7 (1) served in a position described by Subsection (a)
- 8 on or before August 31, 2003; and
- 9 (2) at the time of retirement meets the requirements
- 10 for eligibility for participation in the program as an annuitant as
- those requirements existed on August 31, 2003.
- 12 SECTION 4. Subchapter G, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is
- amended by adding Section 1551.323 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 1551.323. COST OF CERTAIN ANNUITANTS. (a) An
- annuitant eligible to participate under Section 1551.102(i) may be
- 16 required to pay the total cost attributable to the participation of
- 17 that individual and the dependents of that individual until the
- 18 date the individual is 65 years of age.
- 19 (b) This section applies only to an individual who is
- 20 eligible to participate as an annuitant under Section 1551.102(i)
- 21 and who is not eligible to participate under another provision of
- 22 <u>Section 1551.102.</u>
- SECTION 5. Section 1575.004, Insurance Code, as amended by
- 24 S.B. No. 1369, H.B. No. 3459, and H.B. No. 3507, Acts of the 78th
- 25 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is reenacted and amended to
- 26 read as follows:
- Sec. 1575.004. DEFINITION OF RETIREE. In this chapter,

- 1 "retiree" means:
- 2 (1) an individual not eligible for coverage under a
- 3 plan provided under Chapter 1551 or 1601 who:
- 4 (A) is at least 65 years of age and has taken a
- 5 service retirement under the Teacher Retirement System of Texas
- 6 with at least 10 years of service credit in the system for actual
- 7 service in public schools in this state; [or]
- 8 (B) was employed in actual service in public
- 9 schools in this state during or before the 2002-2003 school year, is
- 10 at least 55 years of age, and has taken a service retirement under
- 11 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas with at least 10 years of
- 12 <u>service credit in the system for actual service in public schools in</u>
- 13 <u>this state; or</u>
- 14 (C) has taken a service retirement under the
- 15 Teacher Retirement System of Texas and who has at least 10 years of
- 16 service credit for actual public service in the public schools in
- 17 this state or has at least five years of service credit for actual
- 18 public service in the public schools in this state and has five
- 19 years of military service credited in the Teacher Retirement System
- of Texas, and the sum of the individual's age and amount of service
- 21 credit earned for service in the public schools of this state equals
- or exceeds the number 80; or
- 23 (2) an individual who:
- 24 (A) has taken a disability retirement under the
- 25 Teacher Retirement System of Texas; and
- 26 (B) is entitled to receive monthly benefits from
- 27 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.

- 1 SECTION 6. Section 1575.211, Insurance Code, as added by
- 2 S.B. No. 1369 and H.B. No. 3459, Acts of the 78th Legislature,
- 3 Regular Session, 2003, is amended by adding Subsection (c) to read
- 4 as follows:
- 5 (c) A retiree eligible to participate under Section
- 6 1575.004(1)(B) may be required to pay the total cost attributable
- 7 to the participation of that individual and the dependents of that
- 8 individual until the date the individual is 65 years of age. The
- 9 General Appropriations Act or other similar legislation may specify
- 10 a different allocation of total costs for retirees eligible to
- 11 participate under Section 1575.004(1)(B) and the dependents of
- 12 those retirees. This subsection applies only to an individual who
- 13 <u>is eligible to participate as an annuitant under Section</u>
- 14 1575.004(1)(B) and who is not eligible to participate under another
- provision of Section 1575.004.
- SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if this Act
- 17 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 18 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 19 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 20 effect, this Act takes effect December 1, 2003.
