A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to performance reviews of school districts. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Government Code, is amended by 4 5 adding Section 321.024 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 321.024. PERFORMANCE REVIEW OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS. (a) The committee may periodically review the effectiveness and 7 efficiency of the operations of school districts. A review of a 8 9 school district may be initiated by the committee at its discretion or on the request of the school district. A review may be initiated 10 11 by a school district only by resolution adopted by a majority of the 12 members of the board of trustees of the district. (b) If a review is initiated on the request of the school 13 14 district, the district shall pay 25 percent of the cost incurred in conducting the review. 15 16 (c) The committee shall: (1) prepare a report showing the results of each 17 18 review conducted under this section; (2) file the report with the school district, the 19 governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of 20 21 representatives, the chairs of the standing committees of the senate and the house of representatives with jurisdiction over 22 23 public education, and the commissioner of education; and 24 (3) make the entire report and a summary of the report

2 SECTION 2. Section 403.020, Government Code, is repealed.
3 SECTION 3. On December 1, 2003:

4 (1) all records and other property of the comptroller
5 that relate to a performance review of school districts are
6 transferred to the Legislative Audit Committee;

7 (2) all unexpended and unobligated appropriations to 8 the comptroller relating to the comptroller's performance review of 9 school districts are transferred to the Legislative Audit 10 Committee;

(3) all employees of the comptroller whose primary functions relate to the performance review of school districts become employees of the Legislative Audit Committee; and

14 (4) any reference in law to the comptroller that 15 relates to the performance review of school districts means the 16 Legislative Audit Committee.
