## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the administration of certain legislative agencies.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 321.002(e), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (e) The lieutenant governor and the speaker are joint chairs
- 7 of the committee. The committee shall <u>elect</u> [<del>organize by electing</del>]
- 8 one member to serve as [chairman and one member to serve as]
- 9 secretary.
- SECTION 2. Sections 321.018(b) and (c), Government Code,
- 11 are amended to read as follows:
- 12 (b) Each subpoena must be signed by either of the joint
- 13 <u>chairs of the committee</u> [<del>chairman</del>] or <u>the</u> secretary of the
- 14 committee.
- 15 (c) On the request of either of the joint chairs of the
- 16 <u>committee</u> [chairman] or the secretary of the committee, the
- 17 sergeant at arms or an assistant sergeant at arms of either house of
- 18 the legislature or any peace officer shall serve the subpoena in the
- 19 manner prescribed for service of a district court subpoena.
- SECTION 3. Section 322.001(b), Government Code, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- 22 (b) The lieutenant governor [is the chairman of the board]
- 23 and the speaker are joint chairs of the board [is the
- 24 vice-chairman].

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- 1 SECTION 4. Sections 322.003(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 2 are amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a) A majority of the members of the board from each house
- 4 constitutes a quorum to transact business. If a quorum is present,
- 5 the board may act on any matter that is within its jurisdiction by a
- 6 majority vote.
- 7 (b) The board shall meet as often as necessary to perform
- 8 its duties. Meetings may be held at any time at the request [at the
- 9 call of either of the joint chairs of the board [chairman] or on
- 10 written petition of a majority of the members of the board from each
- 11 house.
- 12 SECTION 5. Section 322.006, Government Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 322.006. APPROVAL OF EXPENSES. Before payment may be
- 15 made on an item of expense for the board, one of the joint chairs of
- 16 the board [chairman] must approve the expense.
- SECTION 6. Section 322.009, Government Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 322.009. INSPECTION COMMITTEES. Either of the joint
- 20 <u>chairs of the board</u> [The chairman], with the approval of the board,
- 21 may appoint a committee to visit, inspect, and report on any state
- institution, department, agency, officer, or employee.
- SECTION 7. Section 322.013(d), Government Code, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:
- 25 (d) For purposes of carrying out its duties, the board may
- 26 administer oaths and issue subpoenas, signed by either of the joint
- 27 chairs of the board [chairman or vice-chairman], to compel the

- 1 attendance of witnesses and the production of books, records, and
- 2 documents. A subpoena of the board shall be served by a peace
- 3 officer in the manner in which district court subpoenas are served.
- 4 On application of the board, a district court of Travis County shall
- 5 compel compliance with a subpoena issued by the board in the same
- 6 manner as for district court subpoenas.
- 7 SECTION 8. Section 323.001(b), Government Code, as amended
- 8 by Senate Bill No. 1418, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular
- 9 Session, 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (b) The council consists of:
- 11 (1) the lieutenant governor;
- 12 (2) the speaker of the house of representatives;
- 13 (3) the chairman of the house administration
- 14 committee;
- 15 (4) five senators from various areas of the state
- 16 appointed by the president of the senate; and
- 17 (5) four [nine] other members of the house of
- 18 representatives from various areas of the state appointed by the
- 19 speaker.
- SECTION 9. Section 323.001(c), Government Code, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- (c) The lieutenant governor and the speaker are joint chairs
- 23 [is the chairman] of the council [and the speaker is the
- 24 vice-chairman].
- SECTION 10. Sections 323.003(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 26 are amended to read as follows:
- 27 (a) The council shall meet as often as necessary to perform

- 1 its duties. Meetings may be held at any time at the request of
- 2 <u>either of the joint chairs of the council.</u>
- 3 (b) A majority of the [Twelve] members of the council from
- 4 each house of the legislature constitutes [including the chairman
- 5 and vice-chairman constitute] a quorum. If a quorum is present, the
- 6 council may act on any matter that is within its jurisdiction by a
- 7 majority vote.
- 8 SECTION 11. Section 323.005(c), Government Code, is amended
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 (c) The certificate of either of the joint chairs of the
- 11 council [chairman or vice-chairman] is sufficient evidence of the
- 12 validity of a claim. On certification, the comptroller shall issue
- 13 warrants on the treasury to pay each claim for mileage and per diem
- 14 expenses, salaries of employees, and other authorized expenses.
- SECTION 12. Sections 323.008(a)-(d), Government Code, are
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) If the council determines a need exists, either of the
- 18 joint chairs [chairman] of the council may appoint statutory
- 19 revision advisory committees to advise the council on matters
- 20 relating to the revision of particular subjects of the law.
- 21 (b) Advisory committees consist of seven members appointed
- 22 by a joint chair [the chairman] of the council. Advisory committee
- 23 members serve for a period of two years from the date of
- 24 appointment.
- 25 (c) In appointing an advisory committee, <u>a joint chair</u> [the
- 26 **chairman**] shall include representatives of the:
- 27 (1) State Bar of Texas;

- 1 (2) judiciary; and
- 2 (3) Texas law schools.
- 3 (d) An advisory committee shall meet at the call of <u>either</u>
  4 of the joint chairs [<del>chairman</del>] of the council.
- 5 SECTION 13. Section 323.011(b), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A subpoena must be signed by <u>either of</u> the <u>joint chairs</u> 8 [chairman] of the council [or the vice-chairman].
- 9 SECTION 14. Section 323.012(b), Government Code, is amended 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (b) On the request of <u>either of</u> the <u>joint chairs</u> [<del>chairman</del>]
  12 of the council [<del>or the vice-chairman</del>], the attorney general shall
  13 render opinions and give advice and assistance to the council.
- SECTION 15. Sections 325.003(a), (d), and (j), Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) The Sunset Advisory Commission consists of <u>five</u> [<u>four</u>]
  17 members of the senate and one public member appointed by the
  18 lieutenant governor and <u>five</u> [<u>four</u>] members of the house of
  19 representatives and one public member appointed by the speaker of
  20 the house. Each appointing authority may designate himself as one
  21 of the legislative appointees.
- 22 (d) Legislative members serve four-year terms, with terms
  23 staggered so that the terms of <u>as near to</u> one-half of the
  24 legislative members appointed by the lieutenant governor <u>as</u>
  25 <u>possible</u> and the terms of <u>as near to</u> one-half of the legislative
  26 members appointed by the speaker <u>as possible</u> expire September 1 of
  27 each odd-numbered year. If the lieutenant governor or the speaker

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- 1 serves on the commission, he continues to serve until resignation
- 2 from the commission or until he ceases to hold the office. Public
- 3 members serve two-year terms expiring September 1 of each
- 4 odd-numbered year.
- 5 (j) Seven [Six] members of the commission constitute a
- 6 quorum. A final action or recommendation may not be made unless
- 7 approved by a record vote of a majority of the commission's full
- 8 membership.
- 9 SECTION 16. If, on the effective date of this Act, more than
- 10 four members of the house of representatives appointed under
- 11 Section 323.001(b)(5), Government Code, are serving as members of
- 12 the Texas Legislative Council:
- 13 (1) those members' terms on the council expire on the
- 14 effective date of this Act; and
- 15 (2) the speaker of the house of representatives, as
- soon as possible after the effective date of this Act, shall appoint
- 17 four members of the house to serve as members of the Texas
- 18 Legislative Council under Section 323.001(b)(5), Government Code,
- 19 as amended by this Act.
- 20 SECTION 17. The lieutenant governor and the speaker of the
- 21 house of representatives, as soon as possible after the effective
- date of this Act, shall appoint a member of the senate or the house
- of representatives, respectively, to serve initial terms on the
- 24 Sunset Advisory Commission under Section 325.003, Government Code,
- as amended by this Act, expiring September 1, 2005.
- SECTION 18. This Act takes effect December 1, 2003.
