A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the determination
- of a quorum of the senate or house of representatives.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 10, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 10. Two-thirds of the members of each House of the
- 7 Legislature, excluding members whom the presiding officer
- 8 <u>determines are absent from the state</u>, shall constitute a quorum to
- 9 do business, but a smaller number may adjourn from day to day, and
- 10 compel the attendance of absent members, in such manner and under
- 11 such penalties as each House may provide.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2004.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to exclude a senator or
- 16 representative who is absent from this state from the determination
- of a quorum needed for a house of the legislature to do business."
