

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, With the passing of Hardy Sanders on March 8, 2003,  
2 at the age of 73, the citizens of Northeast Tarrant County lost a  
3 respected business and civic leader and the state lost one of its  
4 distinguished native sons; and

5           WHEREAS, Widely known as a philanthropist and humanitarian,  
6 Mr. Sanders was a man just as well known for expressing his opinions  
7 in person or through writing letters; he was highly respected for  
8 the strength of his convictions and for his dedicated service to his  
9 fellow Texans; and

10           WHEREAS, The owner of Bates Container in North Richland  
11 Hills, Mr. Sanders was bighearted when asked for donations, but he  
12 also insisted on accountability from the myriad charitable and  
13 civic organizations that he so generously supported; he was willing  
14 to work to ensure that funds were used to maximum benefit, and he  
15 devoted much time and expertise as a board member of such  
16 organizations as the Colleyville Area Chamber of Commerce, the Arts  
17 Council of NorthEast Tarrant County, and the Tarrant County United  
18 Way; and

19           WHEREAS, Describing his reputation as that of a liberal in  
20 conservative circles and a conservative in liberal ones, Hardy  
21 Sanders drew upon his own convictions to make a difference in this  
22 world; although he will be deeply missed, he will long be remembered  
23 for his innate honesty, his sincere dedication to his family and  
24 community, and his good-natured sense of humor; now, therefore, be
