1 WHEREAS, Pastor James Raynard Miller of Houston has long
2 worked for the betterment of his church and community, and it is
3 indeed appropriate that he should be honored for his many
4 contributions as a minister and civic leader at a special service on

7 Moody High School and attended Del Mar College for a year before

18 WHEREAS, The wisdom and counsel of Pastor Miller have
19 benefited numerous professional and community organizations,
20 including the American Baptist Western District Congress, of which
21 he is president, and the Corpus Christi Human Relations Commission,
22 which he served as a member; Pastor Miller serves on the evangelism
23 board of the National Baptist Convention of America, Inc., and is
24 executive secretary of the American Baptist Western District

1 Association; he also has been affiliated with the Sonshine Gospel
2 Hour, the Feed the People ministry, and several citywide seminars;

4 WHEREAS, This devoted family man enjoys the love and support
5 of his wife, Sonja Perry Winchester Miller, and their five
6 children; and

7 WHEREAS, In serving his church and his community, Pastor
8 Miller has provided an inspiring role model of faith, integrity,
9 and compassion, and he is most deserving of the profound esteem in
10 which he is held; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
12 Legislature, 2nd Called Session, hereby commend Pastor James
13 Raynard Miller for his dedicated service to First Shiloh Missionary
14 Baptist Church and extend to him heartfelt best wishes for
