18 demonstrated the pride and vitality of Houston's Taiwanese
19 community and is an inspiration to all those who recognize the value
20 of continuing education; now, therefore, be it

22 Legislature, 2nd Called Session, hereby commemorate the official
23 grand opening of the Houston Taiwan Institute for Senior Citizens
24 and extend to its members and sponsors best wishes for a memorable
