13 counties; during his accomplished tenure, he has played an integral
14 role in restoring the area farm-to-market roadway system and
15 supervised the design and completion of numerous major construction
16 projects; and

18 outstanding example for all those who have had the pleasure of
19 knowing and working with him, and his presence at the Texas
20 Department of Transportation will be greatly missed; now,
