(a) A county attorney may impose, in addition to other 7 costs, \$1 as an administrative cost associated with collecting a 8 toll or charge for each event of nonpayment of a required toll or 9 charge imposed under Section 284.069 in a county with a population 10 11 of 3.3 million or more. 12 (b) Money collected under Subsection (a) shall be deposited in the county treasury in a special fund to be administered by the 13 14 county attorney. Expenditures from the fund shall be at the sole discretion of the attorney and may be used only to defray the 15 salaries and expenses of the attorney's office, but in no event may 16 the county attorney supplement his or her own salary from the fund. 17 18 SECTION 2. Sections 284.208(d) and (e), Transportation Code, as added by Senate Bill No. 1464, Acts of the 78th 19 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, are repealed. 20 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23
