IN RE: HB36 by Madden (Relating to the environmental regulation and remediation of certain dry cleaning facilities.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill amends recently passed legislation, House Bill 1366, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, which the Commission on Environmental Quality is in the process of implementing.
