- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 41.001(a), Election Code, as amended by
- 7 Section 14, Chapter 1315, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular
- 8 Session, 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this subchapter, each
- 10 general or special election in this state shall be held on one of
- 11 the following dates:
- 12 (1) the first Saturday in February;
- 13 (2) the first [third] Saturday in May;
- 14 (3) the second Saturday in September; or
- 15 (4) the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
- 16 November.
- SECTION 2. Section 41.007(b), Election Code, as amended by
- 18 Section 1, Chapter 292, and Section 16, Chapter 1315, Acts of the
- 19 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is reenacted and amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- 21 (b) The runoff primary election date is the second [third]
- 22 Tuesday in April following the general primary election.
- SECTION 3. Section 67.003, Election Code, as amended by
