- 2 relating to services provided by certain mental health
- 3 professionals under the Medicaid program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.027, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The department shall assure that a recipient of medical
- 8 assistance under this chapter may select a licensed psychologist, a
- 9 licensed marriage and family therapist, as defined by Section
- 10 502.002, Occupations Code, a licensed professional counselor, as
- 11 defined by Section 503.002, Occupations Code, or a licensed master
- 12 social worker, as defined by Section 505.002, Occupations Code, to
- 13 perform any health care service or procedure covered under the
- 14 medical assistance program if the selected person is authorized by
- 15 law to perform the service or procedure. This subsection shall be
- 16 liberally construed.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 22 legislative session.
