- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 72.101(a), Property Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) Except as provided by this section and Sections 72.1015
- 7 <u>and</u> [Section] 72.102, personal property is presumed abandoned if,
- 8 for longer than three years:
- 9 (1) the existence and location of the owner of the
- 10 property is unknown to the holder of the property; and
- 11 (2) according to the knowledge and records of the
- 12 holder of the property, a claim to the property has not been
- 13 asserted or an act of ownership of the property has not been
- 14 exercised.
- 15 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 72, Property Code, is
- amended by adding Section 72.1015 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 72.1015. UNCLAIMED WAGES. (a) In this section,
- 18 "wages" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.001, Labor Code.
- (b) An amount of unclaimed wages is presumed abandoned if,
- 20 for longer than one year:
- 21 (1) the existence and location of the person to whom
- the wages are owed is unknown to the holder of the wages; and
- 23 (2) according to the knowledge and records of the
- 24 holder of the wages, a claim to the wages has not been asserted or an

- 1 act of ownership of the wages has not been exercised.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 74.001(a), Property Code, as amended by
- 3 Chapter 894, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003,
- 4 is amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), this chapter
- 6 applies to a holder of property that is presumed abandoned under [+
- 7 [(1)] Chapter 72, Chapter 73, or Chapter 75 [of this
- 8 code; or
- 9 [(2) Subchapter G, Chapter 61, Labor Code].
- SECTION 4. Section 74.101(a), Property Code, as amended by
- 11 Chapter 894, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003,
- is amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) Each holder who on June 30 holds property that is
- 14 presumed abandoned under Chapter 72, 73, or 75 of this code or
- under[7] Chapter 154, Finance Code, [or Subchapter G, Chapter 61,
- 16 Labor Code, shall file a report of that property on or before the
- 17 following November 1. The comptroller may require the report to be
- in a particular format, including a format that can be read by a
- 19 computer.
- SECTION 5. Section 74.301(a), Property Code, as amended by
- 21 Chapter 894, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003,
- 22 is amended to read as follows:
- 23 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), each holder who on
- June 30 holds property that is presumed abandoned under Chapter 72,
- 73, or 75 [of this code or Subchapter G, Chapter 61, Labor Code,]
- 26 shall deliver the property to the comptroller on or before the
- following November 1 accompanied by the report required to be filed

- 2 SECTION 6. Subchapter G, Chapter 61, Labor Code, as added by
- 3 Chapter 894, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003,
- 4 is repealed.
- 5 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 10 legislative session.
