	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to the administration of certain legislative agencies.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 321.002(e), Government Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(e) The lieutenant governor and the speaker are joint chairs
7	of the committee. The committee shall <u>elect</u> [organize by electing]
8	one member to serve as [ <del>chairman and one member to serve as</del> ]
9	secretary.
10	SECTION 2. Sections 321.018(b) and (c), Government Code,
11	are amended to read as follows:
12	(b) Each subpoena must be signed by <u>either of</u> the <u>joint</u>
13	<u>chairs of the committee</u> [ <del>chairman</del> ] or <u>the</u> secretary of the
14	committee.
15	(c) On the request of <u>either of</u> the <u>joint chairs of the</u>
16	<u>committee</u> [ <del>chairman</del> ] or <u>the</u> secretary of the committee, the
17	sergeant at arms or an assistant sergeant at arms of either house of
18	the legislature or any peace officer shall serve the subpoena in the
19	manner prescribed for service of a district court subpoena.
20	SECTION 3. Section 322.001(b), Government Code, is amended
21	to read as follows:
22	(b) The lieutenant governor [ <del>is the chairman of the board</del> ]
23	and the speaker <u>are joint chairs of the board</u> [ <del>is the</del>
24	vice-chairman].

SECTION 4. Sections 322.003(a) and (b), Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

3 (a) A majority of the members of the board from each house
4 constitutes a quorum to transact business. <u>If a quorum is present</u>,
5 <u>the board may act on any matter that is within its jurisdiction by a</u>
6 <u>majority vote</u>.

7 (b) The board shall meet <u>as often as necessary to perform</u> 8 <u>its duties. Meetings may be held at any time at the request</u> [<del>at the</del> 9 <del>call</del>] of <u>either of</u> the joint chairs of the board [<del>chairman</del>] or on 10 written petition of a majority of the members of the board from each 11 house.

SECTION 5. Section 322.006, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 322.006. APPROVAL OF EXPENSES. Before payment may be made on an item of expense for the board, <u>one of</u> the <u>joint chairs of</u> <u>the board</u> [<del>chairman</del>] must approve the expense.

SECTION 6. Section 322.009, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 322.009. INSPECTION COMMITTEES. <u>Either of the joint</u> <u>chairs of the board</u> [<del>The chairman</del>], with the approval of the board, may appoint a committee to visit, inspect, and report on any state institution, department, agency, officer, or employee.

23 SECTION 7. Section 322.013(d), Government Code, is amended 24 to read as follows:

(d) For purposes of carrying out its duties, the board may
administer oaths and issue subpoenas, signed by <u>either of</u> the joint
chairs of the board [chairman or vice-chairman], to compel the

attendance of witnesses and the production of books, records, and documents. A subpoena of the board shall be served by a peace officer in the manner in which district court subpoenas are served. On application of the board, a district court of Travis County shall compel compliance with a subpoena issued by the board in the same manner as for district court subpoenas.

SECTION 8. Section 323.001(b), Government Code, as amended by Senate Bill No. 1418, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is amended to read as follows:

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(b) The council consists of:

( ]

(1) the lieutenant governor;

(2) the speaker of the house of representatives;

13 (3) the chairman of the house administration 14 committee;

15 (4) <u>six</u> [five] senators from various areas of the
16 state appointed by the president of the senate; and

17 (5) <u>five</u> [mine] other members of the house of 18 representatives from various areas of the state appointed by the 19 speaker.

20 SECTION 9. Section 323.001(c), Government Code, is amended 21 to read as follows:

(c) The lieutenant governor <u>and the speaker are joint chairs</u>
[is the chairman] of the council [and the speaker is the
vice-chairman].

25 SECTION 10. Sections 323.003(a) and (b), Government Code, 26 are amended to read as follows:

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(a) The council shall meet as often as necessary to perform

its duties. <u>Meetings may be held at any time at the request of</u>
 <u>either of the joint chairs of the council.</u>

3 (b) <u>A majority of the [Twelve</u>] members of the council <u>from</u> 4 <u>each house of the legislature constitutes</u> [including the chairman 5 <del>and vice-chairman constitute</del>] a quorum. If a quorum is present, the 6 council may act on any matter that is within its jurisdiction by a 7 majority vote.

8 SECTION 11. Section 323.005(c), Government Code, is amended 9 to read as follows:

10 (c) The certificate of <u>either of</u> the joint chairs of the 11 <u>council</u> [chairman or vice-chairman] is sufficient evidence of the 12 validity of a claim. On certification, the comptroller shall issue 13 warrants on the treasury to pay each claim for mileage and per diem 14 expenses, salaries of employees, and other authorized expenses.

SECTION 12. Sections 323.008(a)-(d), Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

(a) If the council determines a need exists, <u>either of</u> the
<u>joint chairs</u> [chairman] of the council may appoint statutory
revision advisory committees to advise the council on matters
relating to the revision of particular subjects of the law.

(b) Advisory committees consist of seven members appointed by <u>a joint chair</u> [the chairman] of the council. Advisory committee members serve for a period of two years from the date of appointment.

(c) In appointing an advisory committee, <u>a joint chair</u> [the
 26 chairman] shall include representatives of the:

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(1) State Bar of Texas;

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(2) judiciary; and

(3) Texas law schools.

3 (d) An advisory committee shall meet at the call of <u>either</u>
4 <u>of the joint chairs</u> [chairman] of the council.

5 SECTION 13. Section 323.011(b), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:

7 (b) A subpoena must be signed by <u>either of</u> the joint chairs
8 [chairman] of the council [or the vice-chairman].

9 SECTION 14. Section 323.012(b), Government Code, is amended 10 to read as follows:

(b) On the request of <u>either of</u> the <u>joint chairs</u> [<del>chairman</del>] of the council [<del>or the vice-chairman</del>], the attorney general shall render opinions and give advice and assistance to the council.

SECTION 15. Sections 325.003(a), (d), and (j), Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

16 (a) The Sunset Advisory Commission consists of <u>five</u> [four] 17 members of the senate and one public member appointed by the 18 lieutenant governor and <u>five</u> [four] members of the house of 19 representatives and one public member appointed by the speaker of 20 the house. Each appointing authority may designate himself as one 21 of the legislative appointees.

(d) Legislative members serve four-year terms, with terms staggered so that the terms of <u>as near to</u> one-half of the legislative members appointed by the lieutenant governor <u>as</u> <u>possible</u> and the terms of <u>as near to</u> one-half of the legislative members appointed by the speaker <u>as possible</u> expire September 1 of each odd-numbered year. If the lieutenant governor or the speaker

1 serves on the commission, he continues to serve until resignation 2 from the commission or until he ceases to hold the office. Public 3 members serve two-year terms expiring September 1 of each 4 odd-numbered year.

5 (j) <u>Seven</u> [Six] members of the commission constitute a 6 quorum. A final action or recommendation may not be made unless 7 approved by a record vote of a majority of the commission's full 8 membership.

9 SECTION 16. (a) If, on the effective date of this Act, more 10 than five members of the house of representatives appointed under 11 Section 323.001(b)(5), Government Code, as amended by this Act, are 12 serving as members of the Texas Legislative Council:

13 (1) those members' terms on the council expire on the 14 effective date of this Act; and

(2) the speaker of the house of representatives, as soon as possible on or after the effective date of this Act, shall appoint five members of the house to serve as members of the Texas Legislative Council under Section 323.001(b)(5), Government Code, as amended by this Act.

(b) The lieutenant governor, as soon as possible on or after the effective date of this Act, shall appoint an additional senator to serve as a member of the Texas Legislative Council under Section 323.001(b)(4), Government Code, as amended by this Act.

SECTION 17. The lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of representatives, as soon as possible on or after the effective date of the section of this Act that amends Section 325.003, Government Code, shall appoint a member of the senate or

the house of representatives, respectively, to serve an initial term on the Sunset Advisory Commission under Section 325.003, Government Code, as amended by this Act, expiring September 1, 2005.

5 SECTION 18. The section of this Act that amends Section 6 325.003, Government Code, takes effect immediately if this Act 7 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 8 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 9 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate 10 effect, that section takes effect on the 91st day after the last day 11 of the legislative session.

12 SECTION 19. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this 13 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 14 legislative session.
