6	adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
7	(c) Property distributable in the course of a
8	demutualization or related reorganization of an insurance company
9	is presumed abandoned on the first anniversary of the date the
10	property becomes distributable if, at the time of the first
11	distribution, the last known address of the owner according to the
12	records of the holder of the property is known to be incorrect or
13	the distribution or statements related to the distribution are
14	returned by the post office as undeliverable and the owner has not:
15	(1) communicated in writing with the holder of the

 16 property or the holder's agent regarding the interest; or
- 17 (2) otherwise communicated with the holder regarding
 18 the interest as evidenced by a memorandum or other record on file
 19 with the holder or its agents.
- 20 <u>(d) Property distributable in the course of a</u>
 21 <u>demutualization or related reorganization of an insurance company</u>
 22 <u>that is not subject to Subsection (c) is presumed abandoned as</u>
 23 <u>otherwise provided by this section.</u>
- 24 SECTION 2. This article takes effect immediately if this
