(a) The additional revenue generated by the increase in the amount of lobby registration fees under Section 1-13 305.0064, Government Code, as added by Chapter 249, Acts of the 78th 1-14 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, collected during the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2003, by the Texas Ethics Commission is appropriated, in an amount not to exceed \$267,400, to 1**-**15 1**-**16 1-17 the Texas Ethics Commission for the state fiscal biennium beginning 1-18 September 1, 2003, for the development and implementation of the electronic filing system for lobbyists, as required by Section 1-19 1-20 1-21 305.0064.
