A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to making an appropriation to the University of Texas  
3 Health Science Center at San Antonio for the purpose of supporting  
4 the Regional Academic Health Center and the Laredo Extension  
5 Campus, and making an appropriation to the University of Texas  
6 Health Science Center at Houston for the purpose of completing  
7 building construction of the Regional Academic Health Center at the  
8 University of Texas School of Public Health at the Brownsville  
9 Regional Campus.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

11 SECTION 1. In addition to other amounts appropriated to The  
12 University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio for all or  
13 part of the state fiscal biennium that began September 1, 2003, for  
14 the purpose of supporting the Regional Academic Health Center, the  
15 amount of \$19,161,612 is appropriated out of the general revenue  
16 fund to The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio  
17 for the state fiscal biennium that began September 1, 2003, for the  
18 purpose of supporting the Regional Academic Health Center  
19 established under Section 74.611, Education Code, to serve the  
20 Lower Rio Grande Valley.

21 SECTION 2. In addition to other amounts appropriated to The  
22 University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio for all or  
23 part of the state fiscal biennium that began September 1, 2003, for  
24 the purpose of supporting the programs and operations of the Laredo

1 Campus Extension, the amount of \$3,765,507 is appropriated out of  
2 the general revenue fund to The University of Texas Health Science  
3 Center at San Antonio for the state fiscal biennium that began  
4 September 1, 2003, for the purpose of supporting the programs and  
5 operations of the Laredo Campus Extension.

6 SECTION 3. In addition to other amounts appropriated to The  
7 University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston for all or part  
8 of the state fiscal biennium that began September 1, 2003, for the  
9 purpose of completing building construction of the Regional  
10 Academic Health Center at the University of Texas School of Public  
11 Health - Brownsville Regional Campus, the amount of \$2,000,000 is  
12 appropriated out of the general revenue fund to The University of  
13 Texas Health Science Center at Houston for the state fiscal  
14 biennium that began September 1, 2003, for the purpose of  
15 completing building construction of the Regional Academic Health  
16 Center at the University of Texas School of Public Health -  
17 Brownsville Regional Campus established under Section 74.611,  
18 Education Code, to serve the Lower Rio Grande Valley.

19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
23 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the  
24 legislative session.
