BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Sections 39.907(b) and (h), Utilities Code, as amended or added by Section 12 of Senate Bill No. 1418 and Section 1 1-12 1-13 of House Bill No. 1948, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, are reenacted and amended to read as follows: 1-14

(b) The committee is composed of six members as follows:

1**-**15 1**-**16 (1) the chair of the House Committee on Regulated 1-17 Industries [State Affairs]; 1-18

(2) three members of the senate appointed by the lieutenant governor; and

1-20 1-21 (3) two members of the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.

1-22 The chair of the House Committee on Regulated Industries (h) 1-23 [State Affairs] and one of the members of the senate serving on the committee, designated by the lieutenant governor, shall serve as 1-24 1-25 joint chairs of the committee.

1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 1-29 1-30 1-31 legislative session.

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
