H.B. No. 52

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to the filing of personal financial disclosure statements  
3 by municipal officers and candidates, members of the boards of  
4 trustees of school districts, and directors of sports and community  
5 venue districts.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 145.003, Local Government Code, as added  
8 by Chapter 249, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session,  
9 2003, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection  
10 (c) to read as follows:

11 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a [A] municipal  
12 officer or a candidate for a municipal office filled by election  
13 shall file a financial statement as required by this chapter.

14 (c) A municipal officer who does not receive compensation  
15 for serving as an officer or a candidate for such an office is not  
16 required to file a financial statement under this chapter.

17 SECTION 2. Section 11.064, Education Code, as added by  
18 Chapter 249, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003,  
19 is repealed.

20 SECTION 3. Section 335.1085, Local Government Code, as  
21 added by Chapter 249, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular  
22 Session, 2003, is repealed.

23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
3 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the  
4 legislative session.
