## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the right of an adopted person to have access to the 3 person's original birth certificate. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 192.008, Health and Safety Code, 5 is 6 amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (f) to 7 read as follows: (d) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [Subsection] (e) and 8 (f), only the court that granted the adoption may order access to an 9 original birth certificate and the filed documents on which a 10 supplementary certificate is based. 11 12 (f) An adult adoptee who is applying for access to the 13 person's original birth certificate and who knows the identity of 14 each parent named on the original birth certificate is entitled to a copy of the original birth certificate without obtaining a court 15 16 order. SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect February 1, 2004. 17 18 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies to access to an original birth certificate by an adopted person without regard 19 to whether the adoption order for the person was rendered before, 20 21 on, or after the effective date of this Act.
