AN ACT

- 2 relating to the annexation of territory to a public junior college

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 130.063(a), Education Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Territory may be annexed to the junior college district
- 8 for junior college purposes only, by either contract or election,
- 9 if:

- 10 (1) the territory:
- (A) $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ consists of a school district or part
- of a school district or a county or part of a county; and
- (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ is adjacent to the junior college
- 14 district or located in the service area of the district established
- 15 under Subchapter J; and
- 16 (2) for any territory located in the service area of
- another junior college district, the governing board of the other
- 18 junior college district, not earlier than one year before the date
- 19 the annexation takes effect, approves the annexation of the
- 20 <u>applicable territory</u>.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

- 1 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
