5 Booker T. Washington High School in Dallas and went on to attend  
6 Wiley College in Marshall; Mrs. Cary subsequently enjoyed a  
7 successful 28-year career with the Fort Worth Independent School  
8 District as a secretary in local schools until her retirement; and

9           WHEREAS, A woman who treasured her religious beliefs, she was  
10 a valued congregant of Rising Star Missionary Baptist Church, where  
11 for many years she was a member of the choir; and

12           WHEREAS, Mrs. Cary shared 58 years with her husband, Reby  
13 Cary, whom she lovingly supported throughout his three terms in the  
14 Texas House of Representatives; a proud and devoted mother, she  
15 nurtured and sustained her daughter Faith with tenderness, insight,  
16 and wisdom; and

17           WHEREAS, In addition to caring for her family, Mrs. Cary gave  
18 generously of her time and many talents to a host of worthwhile  
19 community endeavors; LINKS, Inc., the Maid and Matron Club, Fort  
20 Worth Republican Women, and the Bunche-Ellington Club were among  
21 the numerous organizations that benefited from her tireless  
22 enthusiasm; and
