2 August 9, 2003, at the age of 97, brought a great loss to the family
3 and friends of this esteemed gentleman; and

4 WHEREAS, Born May 24, 1906, in Allende, Coahuila, Mexico, Mr.
5 Chavira came to the United States in 1921 and worked for 57 years as
6 a contract sheep shearer to provide for his family; he supplemented
7 his income through 20 years of employment as a seasonal migrant
8 worker; and

9 WHEREAS, A staunch believer in the power of education, this
10 beloved patriarch encouraged his children to pursue college
11 degrees, and his children and grandchildren responded by earning
12 degrees from such respected institutions as Howard Payne
13 University, Sul Ross State University, Southwest Texas State
14 University, and The University of Texas at Austin; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Chavira was preceded in death by his first wife,
16 Maria de Jesus Chavira, his son, Jesus Chavira, Jr., and his
17 grandson, Ruben Chavira; he endured these hardships with uncommon
18 strength of character and kept these family members alive in his
19 memories; and

20 WHEREAS, Throughout his long and productive life, Mr. Chavira
21 placed the needs of his family before his own, and although he will
22 be missed by all who knew and loved him, his spirit will shine on for
23 many years to come in the thoughts and deeds of his large and loving
24 family; now, therefore, be it
