2 true heroism on February 6, 2003, when he attempted to resuscitate a  
3 five-month-old baby, and his efforts have earned him the Department  
4 of Public Safety's prestigious Director's Citation Award; and

5           WHEREAS, Trooper Urbanovsky received the citation from  
6 Department of Public Safety director Thomas A. Davis, Jr., at a  
7 ceremony held in Austin; he also received a pin to be worn on his  
8 uniform, signifying receipt of the award; and

9           WHEREAS, A dedicated public servant, Trooper Urbanovsky came  
10 to the aid of his neighbors in their time of need, performing CPR on  
11 their infant until fire department and emergency personnel arrived  
12 to transport the baby to the Children's Hospital in Austin; and

13           WHEREAS, The citizens of Texas are fortunate to have highly  
14 skilled men and women among us to assist in emergency situations,  
15 and Trooper Urbanovsky is a credit to both the Department of Public  
16 Safety and the law enforcement profession; now, therefore, be it

18 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby commend Dwayne Urbanovsky  
19 for his heroism and congratulate him on his receipt of the
