6 bestowed on Dr. Hansen by ASCAP, which selects honorees based on  
7 published works, performances for the calendar year, current  
8 compositions under way, and quality of musical compositions; and

10 as a composer, and his works have been performed at Carnegie Hall in  
11 New York, at the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in  
12 Washington, D.C., and on National Educational Television;

14 during concerts at The University of Texas at Arlington and Texas  
15 A&M University--Commerce; in addition, this gifted gentleman  
16 enjoys a reputation as a jazz pianist who often entertains at Texas

19 has achieved excellence in the field of music, and it is a pleasure
