R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Sarah Norman of Canton is retiring from the Van
2 Zandt County Library Advisory Board, bringing to a close a
3 distinguished two-term tenure that has been characterized by
4 integrity and excellence; and

5 WHEREAS, The advisory board oversees the day-to-day
6 operations of the library and makes recommendations for its
7 operation to the Van Zandt County Commissioners Court; during Mrs.
8 Norman's term, the library received numerous grants and awards,
9 developed and adopted a policies and procedures manual, and
10 expanded existing parking facilities; and

11 WHEREAS, In her role as an advisory board member, Mrs. Norman
12 has been instrumental in the decision-making process and has shared
13 her knowledge and expertise with her fellow board members; she is
14 also a longtime library volunteer whose service predates the
15 library's move to its current location; and

16 WHEREAS, Through her dedication and commitment, Mrs. Norman
17 has gained the respect of her fellow board members and the
18 admiration of many citizens of Van Zandt County, and she is indeed
19 deserving of special recognition for her six years of service on the
20 Advisory Board of the Van Zandt County Library; now, therefore, be
