R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Rollin A. Sininger of Canton is retiring from the
2 Van Zandt County Library Advisory Board, bringing to a close a
3 distinguished two-term tenure that has been characterized by
4 integrity and excellence; and

5 WHEREAS, The advisory board oversees the day-to-day
6 operations of the library and makes recommendations for its
7 operation to the Van Zandt County Commissioners Court; during Mr.
8 Sininger's term, the library received numerous grants and awards,
9 developed and adopted a policies and procedures manual, and
10 expanded existing parking facilities; and

11 WHEREAS, In his role as an advisory board member, Mr.
12 Sininger has been instrumental in the decision-making process and
13 has shared his knowledge and expertise with his fellow board
14 members; he is also an active member of the Canton Lions Club,
15 Canton Main Street, and First Baptist Church; and

17 has gained the respect of his fellow board members and the
18 admiration of many citizens of Van Zandt County, and he is indeed
19 deserving of special recognition for his six years of service on the
