## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The State of Texas Anniversary Remembrance (STAR) 2 Day bill (SB-1656) was passed by the 76th State of Texas Legislature 3 and signed into law by Governor George W. Bush on June 18, 1999 and 4 stated that all Texas public schools and other organizations shall 5 celebrate the birthday of the State of Texas on the 19th of February 6 each year with appropriate and patriotic programs to inspire a 7 greater appreciation for the history of our state; and

8 WHEREAS, THE GREAT TEXAS BLOOD DONOR ROUNDUP CAMPAIGN was organized and established by The State of Texas Anniversary 9 Remembrance (STAR) Day Foundation on February 19, 2001 as an 10 appropriate and patriotic annual statewide program with a MISSION 11 12 to educate, inspire and motivate students to become our future 13 blood donors to help alleviate the growing Texas blood supply 14 shortage in partnership with all Texas public schools by sponsoring SCHOOL ROUNDUP events hosted by School Board Presidents at the 15 1,754 Texas public schools serving seventh and eight grade students 16 where students as a public service after-school activity invite 17 their parents, brothers and sisters of age (17 years of age or 18 older) grandparents and relatives, school employees, community 19 friends and high school students of age to donate blood to help 20 21 alleviate the growing Texas blood supply shortage as their personal 22 STAR DAY birthday present for our each year; and

23 WHEREAS, The Galveston County Dickinson Independent School 24 District Board of Trustees President Alvin Alton Pool hosted the

first SCHOOL ROUNDUP event in Texas at R. D. McAdams Junior High School in partnership with volunteer students, parents, school employees and friends of the school district on Saturday, March 2, 2002 in their school cafeteria from 9am till 4pm to ROUNDUP adults and Dickinson High School students of age to donate blood to help alleviate the growing Texas blood supply shortage as their school STAR DAY birthday present for our state; and

8 WHEREAS, The State of Texas Anniversary Remembrance (STAR) Day Foundation is inviting all Texas Public School Board Presidents 9 in the 1,055 Texas public school districts to host an annual SCHOOL 10 ROUNDUP event at each of their 1,754 Texas public schools serving 11 seventh and eight grade students to provide an opportunity for the 12 nearly 600,000 students in the seventh and eight grades of Texas 13 14 public schools to volunteer and donate their time in an 15 after-school setting as their annual student STAR DAY birthday present for our state to help ROUNDUP their parents, brothers and 16 17 sisters of age (17 years or older), grandparents and relatives, school employees and community friends to blood to help alleviate 18 19 the growing Texas blood supply shortage at a school ROUNDUP event by signing a STUDENT ROUNDUP PLEDGE letter approved by parents in 20 which the volunteer students pledge to read four (4) books and 21 complete eight (8) hours of public service work in an after-school 22 23 setting as their annual student STAR DAY birthday president for our 24 state to challenge and motivate an adult to donate a pint of blood to help alleviate the growing Texas blood supply shortage; and 25

26 WHEREAS, On September 26, 2002, Governor Rick Perry issued 27 Executive Order RP-19 in which the Governor noted that donating

blood provides a lifesaving service to patients with cancer, burns, transplants, and other surgeries and encouraged each state agency in Texas to allow their employees to take one hour of compensatory or vacation time to donate blood to address this current shortage; and

6 WHEREAS, On May 29, 2003 Governor Rick Perry signed House 7 Bill 89 which was authored by Representative Ruth Jones McClendon 8 establishing a TEXAS EMPLOYEE DONOR LEAVE OF ABSENCE (TEDLOA) 9 POLICY for certain employees of Texas agencies providing paid leave 10 of absence to donate blood, bone marrow and organs; and

WHEREAS, On May 22, 2003, Representative Bob Hunter, 11 Representative Elizabeth Jones (an author of House Bill 89), and 12 Senator Kyle Janek, MD hosted the inaugural GREAT TEXAS BLOOD DONOR 13 ROUNDUP AT THE STATE CAPITOL event which was coordinated by Mr. Tim 14 15 Flynn, State Capitol Nurse and sponsored by The State of Texas Anniversary Remembrance (STAR) Day Foundation to answer the call of 16 17 Governor Perry in the spirit of his Executive Order RP-19 and in support of House Bill 89 to provide an opportunity for all elected 18 19 individuals, State Capitol legislative office employees and employees of State Capitol agencies to donate blood to help 20 21 alleviate the growing Texas blood supply shortage as their annual personal STAR DAY birthday presents for our state; and 22

WHEREAS, On July 3, 2003 Manny C. Morales, owner of a State Farm Insurance Agency in El Paso Texas, joined THE GREAT TEXAS BLOOD DONOR ROUNDUP CAMPAIGN by adopting the TEXAS EMPLOYEE DONOR LEAVE OF ABSENCE (TEDLOA) POLICY for his employees to answer the call of Governor Rick Perry in the spirit of his Executive Order RP-19 and

in support of House Bill 89 and has also agreed to donate one book to an area partnering school hosting a SCHOOL ROUNDUP event in the name of employee and the agency for each pint of blood donated by an employee at an official ROUNDUP event; and

5 WHEREAS, On September 8, 2003, Loving County Judge Donald C. 6 Creager and the Loving County Commissioners joined THE GREAT TEXAS 7 BLOOD DONOR ROUNDUP CAMPAIGN by approving the first TEXAS EMPLOYEE 8 DONOR LEAVE OF ABSENCE (TEDOLA) POLICY for county employees by 9 adopting a Loving County Commissioners' Court Resolution to answer 10 the call of Governor Rick Perry in the spirit of his Executive Order 11 RP-19 and in support of House Bill 89; and

12 WHEREAS, On September 8, 2003, the City of Wink Mayor Betty 13 Lou Dodd and the City of Wink Alderpersons in Winkler County joined 14 THE GREAT TEXAS BLOOD DONOR ROUNDUP CAMPAIGN by approving the first 15 TEXAS EMPLOYEE DONOR LEAVE OF ABSENCE (TEDOLA) POLICY for 16 incorporate city employees by adopting a City of Wink Resolution to 17 answer the call of Governor Rick Perry in the spirit of his 18 Executive Order RP-19 and in support of House Bill 89; and

WHEREAS, The State of Texas Anniversary Remembrance (STAR) 19 Day Foundation shall commemorate the birthday of the Great State of 20 21 Texas Each year on the nineteenth day of February by inviting all 254 Texas Counties, the 1,203 incorporate Texas cities, the many 22 tens of thousands of Texas corporations and small businesses to 23 24 adopt a TEXAS EMPLOYEE DONOR LEAVE OF ABSENCE (TEDLOA) POLICY for 25 their respective employees to encourage, motivate and mobilize their employees to donate blood to help alleviate the growing Texas 26 27 blood supply shortage to answer the call of Governor Rick Perry in

the spirit of his RP-19 and in support of House Bill 89 and to invite their employees to visit seventh and eight grade schools hosting SCHOOL ROUNDUP events to donate blood; and; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas, Third Called Session, hereby recognize February 2004, as THE GREAT
