## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Highly regarded in the labor movement, Ms. Walker 4 5 directs community services and volunteers for the Texas organization; among her other responsibilities, she coordinates 6 7 union disaster relief operations, voter registration and get-out-the-vote drives, lobbying activities in behalf of numerous 8 issues, and preparations for special events; and 9

WHEREAS, A Hemphill native and Pineland High School alumna, 10 11 Ms. Walker joined the Communication Workers of America (CWA) 12 through her career with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, later 13 taking on the role of a commercial job steward and member of CWA's 14 executive board; she became a full-time organizer for the AFL-CIO's industrial union department, worked with the Harris County AFL-CIO, 15 16 and, since 1965, has been on staff with the Texas AFL-CIO, including serving as women's activities director; and 17

WHEREAS, This exceptional individual and Texas Women's Hall of Fame member contributes her time and resources in behalf of many worthy endeavors at the national, statewide, and local levels; she has served as state vice president of the Texas Coalition of Labor Union Women, is a founder of the Texas Consumer Association, a member of the Democratic National Committee, and a past member of the Texas Judicial Conduct Commission; she was a pioneer in the
