- 2 Texas actor, teacher, and author of the heart-rending memoir,
- 3 Confessions of a No Name Actor; and
- WHEREAS, The play benefits the Sunshine Kids, a Texas-based
- 5 charity that provides group activities and emotional support to
- 6 children with cancer; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Port Arthur native and Hollywood acting legend
- 8 G. W. Bailey, who portrayed Sergeant Rizzo on M*A*S*H and Captain
- 9 Harris in the Police Academy movies, among many other distinguished
- 10 roles, is the executive director of the Sunshine Kids and a leading
- 11 actor in "Sonny's Last Shot"; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Sunshine Kids organization has brought joy and
- 13 solace to thousands of children, helping them do what children
- 14 should do: celebrate life; and
- WHEREAS, Anything that helps the Sunshine Kids can't be all
- 16 bad; now, therefore, be it
