15 the Oblates of Mary Immaculate Seminary in San Antonio; and

17 humanitarian organizations, and the commendable efforts of the
18 members of St. Rose of Lima Court No. 827 are a tribute to the legacy
19 of service provided by the Catholic Daughters of the Americas; now,
