Suspending limitations on conference committee jurisdiction, H.B. No. 1 (Denny/Nelson)

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 1 Texas, 78th Legislature, 3rd Called Session, 2003, That House Rule 2 3 13, Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 5 resolve the differences on H.B. No. 1, relating to the dates of and procedures for certain elections, the procedures for canvassing the 6 7 ballots for an election, and the counting of certain ballots voted by mail, to consider and take action on the following matters: 8

- 9 (1) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(3), is suspended to permit 10 the committee to make SECTION 1 of the bill, which provides for a 11 change in the uniform election dates in Section 41.001(a), Election 12 Code, effective January 1, 2005.
- Explanation: The addition of text on this matter is necessary to avoid conflicts between the elections held on uniform election dates and the primary and runoff primary elections to be held in 2004.
- 17 (2) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit
 18 the committee to add text to set the 2004 general primary election
 19 and 2004 presidential primary election on March 9, 2004, to set the
 20 2004 runoff primary election on April 13, 2004, and to resolve
 21 conflicts between elections held on those dates and other
 22 provisions of the Election Code.
- Explanation: The addition of text on this matter is necessary to allow for the use of the congressional districts
