1 WHEREAS, The family and friends of Jose Chon Hinojosa of
2 Edcouch were deeply saddened by the passing of this esteemed Texan
3 on October 2, 2003, at the age of 66; and

4 WHEREAS, Born on December 8, 1936, to an Edcouch pioneer
5 family, Mr. Hinojosa graduated from Edcouch-Elsa High School and
6 became a farmer and one of the first Hispanic custom harvest
7 operators in the Delta area; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Hinojosa was chosen by President Jimmy Carter to
9 represent Texas on an agriculture committee composed of eight
10 grassroots farmers from across the United States; he further served
11 his community as mayor and city councilman for the City of Edcouch;

13 WHEREAS, Through hard work and dedication, Mr. Hinojosa made
14 significant contributions of lasting benefit to his hometown, and
15 he will not soon be forgotten; now, therefore, be it
