2 recognize gallant and intrepid service by a member of the United
3 States Army, and through his courageous actions in Vietnam, Joel
4 Jimenez distinguished himself as a worthy recipient of this
5 prestigious medal; and

6 WHEREAS, Over the course of his military service, Mr.
7 Jimenez, a former specialist in the 77th Armor Regiment, 5th
8 Infantry Division, acted with valor and distinction and made a
9 commendable contribution to his fellow citizens; and

10 WHEREAS, The Combat Infantryman Badge was awarded to Mr.
11 Jimenez on November 25, 1969, for his performance of duty while
12 under hostile fire, as he engaged in active ground combat with the
13 enemy in the Republic of Vietnam; this courageous gentleman will
14 finally be presented with his well-deserved medal on October 20,
15 2003, at Sheppard Air Force Base; and

16 WHEREAS, Through his unfaltering devotion to duty, honor, and
17 his country, Joel Jimenez embodies the highest ideals of the armed
