4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 2(11)(A), Development Corporation Act of

1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to

7 read as follows:

- 9 equipment, facilities, expenditures, targeted infrastructure, and

improvements (one or more) that are for the creation or retention of

11 primary jobs and that are found by the board of directors to be

required or suitable for the development, retention, or expansion

of manufacturing and industrial facilities, research and

development facilities, transportation facilities (including but

15 not limited to airports, ports, mass commuting facilities, and

16 parking facilities), sewage or solid waste disposal facilities,

recycling facilities, air or water pollution control facilities,

18 facilities for the furnishing of water to the general public,

19 distribution centers, small warehouse facilities capable of

serving as decentralized storage and distribution centers, primary

21 job training facilities for use by institutions of higher

education, and regional or national corporate headquarters

23 facilities.

- 2 enterprises and other enterprises described by this Act, as

- 4 "Project" also includes expenditures found by the board
- 5 of directors to be required or suitable for infrastructure

- 7 enterprises limited to streets and roads, rail spurs, water and
- 8 electric utilities, gas utilities, drainage and related
- 9 improvements, and telecommunications and Internet improvements.
