WHEREAS, He has served as a member of the board of numerous organizations, including the Government Agencies Dallas Federal Credit Union and the Dallas Black Chamber of Commerce; he is a founder and board member of the North Texas Commission, a life member of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, and a member of New Hope Baptist Church; and

WHEREAS, Over the years, Mr. Bailey has received a number of honors and awards, including the United States Treasury Department's Albert Gallatin Award and the Government Agencies Dallas Federal Credit Union Award; he is most proud of his Omega Man Award and a Panhellenic Council Award; and

WHEREAS, Widely respected for his service to his community, James Bailey is an exemplary leader and a selfless role model for others to follow, and he deserves legislative recognition for his many accomplishments; now, therefore, be it
