Fiscal Analysis

The bill would make appropriation sto the Texas Ethics Commission for registration fees used towards the development and implementation of an electronic filing system for lobby reports contained Section 305.0064, Government Code, as added by Chapter 249, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session. The Comptroller of Public Accounts did include the revenue gain in the certification of House Bill 1, the general appropriation sact. Therefore, the appropriation and cost shown above would count against

the amount estimated to be available for certification for the 78th Legislature, Third Called Session.

Methodology

The estimated fee collections in House Bill 1606 are \$215,000 in fiscal year 2004 and \$48,000 in fiscal year 2005.

Technology

The technology impact includes two servers and associated software at a cost of \$143,140.
