# Nosignificantfiscalimplication to the State is anticipated.

ThisbillmakesseveralchangestotheTexasCommissiononEnvironmentalQuality's(TCEQ's) performance-basedregulatorysystem.Itwouldestablishasetofstandardsfortheclassificationofa person'scompliancehistoryataparticularsite,anditwouldrequiretheTCEQtodevelopcompliance standardsandclassifycategoriesofregulatedentitiesbeinginspectedatleastannually.Theagency expectsthatthesechangeswouldrequirenewrulemaking,guidance,andextensiveprogramming changestotheConsolidatedComplianceandEnforcementDatabaseaswellastheStateofTexas EnvironmentalElectronicReportingSystem.Theagencyalsoexpectsthatadditionalstaff resourceswouldberequiredtotrack,classifyandscorecompliancehistory.

This estimate assumes that any costs associated with implementing the provisions of the bill would be spread among several methods of finance, and that the rewould be no significant impact to any individual account. This estimate also assumes that the agency would not require significant additional FTE stoimplement the provisions of the bill.
