Nosignificantfiscalimplication to the State is anticipated.

The bill makes changes to the Commission on Environmental Quality's (TCEQ) performance regulatory program. Changes would apply only to permit sorpermit amendments filed after the date that final rules would be published in the Texas Register and to enforce mentactions occurring on or after that date.

The bill would take effect immediately, assuming that it received the requisite two votes in both houses of the Legislature, otherwise it would take effect January 15,2004.

None of the changes made by the billis expected to result in significant fiscal implications to the TCEQ.
