(2) [the rate of \$0.06 per \$100 of taxable value; and

[(3)] the district's current debt rate.

(35) Add the following appropriately numbered Section to Part A of Article 4 of the bill to read as follows:

SECTION 4A.\_\_\_. Subchapter A, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended by adding Section 151.0043 to read as follows:

Sec. 151.0043. "MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIR SERVICES." (a) "Motor vehicle repair services" means the repair, remodeling, maintenance, or restoration of a motor vehicle, including testing or diagnostic services, body repair and painting, engine repair, transmission repair, exhaust system repair, brake repair, and air

conditioning repair.

(b) "Motor vehicle repair services" does not include any vehicle emissions tests required by law, safety inspection tests required by law, and other similar tests required by law.
