- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 411.185, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter,
- 8 <u>a veteran may not be required to complete the range instruction</u>
- 9 portion of a handgun proficiency course to renew a concealed
- 10 handgun license issued under this subchapter. In this subsection,
- "veteran" means an individual who served in:
- 12 (1) the army, navy, air force, coast guard, or marine
- 13 corps of the United States; or
- 14 (2) an auxiliary service of one of those branches of
- 15 the armed forces.
- 16 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 17 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 18 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 19 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 20 effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of
- 21 the legislative session.
- (b) The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 23 application for renewal of a concealed handgun license submitted to
- 24 the Department of Public Safety on or after the effective date of

- 1 this Act. An application for renewal that is submitted to the
- 2 Department of Public Safety before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 covered by the law in effect when the application was submitted, and
- 4 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
