- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2.204(b), Family Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) The 72-hour waiting period after issuance of a marriage
- 8 license does not apply to an applicant who:
- 9 (1) is a member of the armed forces of the United
- 10 States and on active duty; [or]
- 11 (2) is not a member of the armed forces of the United
- 12 States but performs work for the United States Department of
- 13 Defense as a department employee or under a contract with the
- 14 department; or
- 15 (3) obtains a written waiver under Subsection (c).
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 17 marriage license issued on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 A marriage license issued before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the license was issued,
- and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
