## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing that political 2 subdivisions are exempt from unfunded legislative mandates.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by adding Section 67 to read as follows:
- Sec. 67. (a) In this section, "legislative mandate" means
  a statutory provision enacted by the legislature that requires a
  political subdivision to establish, expand, or modify an activity
  in a way that requires an expenditure of revenue that would not have
- 10 been required in the absence of the provision.
- 11 (b) For purposes of this section, a legislative mandate is
- 12 <u>considered to be unfunded during any period for which the</u>
- 13 <u>legislature</u> has not appropriated or otherwise provided funds, other
- 14 than revenue of the political subdivision, estimated to be
- 15 sufficient to meet the cost of financing the expenditure, as
- 16 determined by law.
- 17 (c) A political subdivision is exempt from a legislative
- 18 mandate during a period in which the mandate is unfunded. The
- 19 <u>legislature by general law shall authorize a state officer or state</u>
- 20 agency, which may include members of the legislature, to identify
- 21 <u>legislative mandates and determine whether a legislative mandate is</u>
- 22 considered unfunded for a specific period.
- 23 (d) This section does not apply to:
- 24 (1) a legislative mandate enacted before January 1,

- 1 2004;
- 2 (2) a legislative mandate that is necessary to comply
- 3 with a requirement of the Texas Constitution, federal law, or a
- 4 <u>court order; or</u>
- 5 (3) a legislative mandate that creates a criminal
- 6 offense or changes the elements of a criminal offense.
- 7 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 8 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2004.
- 9 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 10 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing that
- 11 political subdivisions are exempt from unfunded legislative
- 12 mandates."
