1 WHEREAS, The Honorable Frank M. Parker III is retiring in
2 2004 as mayor of Magnolia, after guiding the city through many
3 improvements in city services, infrastructure, and business
4 procedures; and

5 WHEREAS, A longtime resident of Magnolia, Mayor Parker is
6 currently completing a second term as head of the municipal
7 government; outside of this office, he is an accomplished engineer
8 and professional consultant for occupational health, safety, and
9 environmental issues who also serves as vice president of
10 operations for Environment Technologies, Inc.; and

11 WHEREAS, This distinguished Texan has given unstintingly of
12 his time and efforts in behalf of his community and the State of
13 Texas; in past years, he has served on the board of the Magnolia
14 Area Chamber of Commerce and as a city council member; he has also
15 shared his professional expertise as a member of the Texas
16 Department of Health Asbestos Advisory Committee; and

17 WHEREAS, A retired U.S. Air Force colonel, Mayor Parker has
18 brought to bear on his responsibilities in city government the same
19 sense of duty that characterized his career in the military, and the
20 citizens of Magnolia have benefited greatly from his sure
21 leadership; now, therefore, be it
