15 stalwart volunteer in organizations that promote health and
16 education; she was also an active congregant of First Baptist
17 Church, where she participated in the choir, Sunday school,
18 missions, and the Senior Ambassadors; and

20 with church and civic groups, Mrs. Pina will also be remembered
21 fondly for the highly prized hot sauce that she created and for her
22 thoughtful, homemade gifts; and

24 and those less fortunate, and the blessing of her life will long be

1 cherished by all who were privileged to share in her love and
2 friendship; now, therefore, be it
