5 WHEREAS, Born and raised in Corpus Christi, Mr. Garza was a 6 skilled debater and golfer who competed at the statewide level in 7 both vocations during his years as a student at King High School; he 8 went on to graduate from Texas Tech University and The University of 9 Texas School of Law in Austin, winning the latter's mock trial 10 competition before earning his law degree in 1986; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Garza became one of the Lone Star State's top 12 litigators and worked as a senior attorney and deputy division 13 chief for the general litigation division of the attorney general's 14 office and as a litigator for American Airlines in Dallas over the 15 course of his career; in each position, Mr. Garza demonstrated the 16 utmost professionalism and integrity, earning the esteem and 17 admiration of his colleagues; and

18 WHEREAS, Passionate in the pursuit of equal treatment for 19 all, he championed the cause of civil rights in local and state 20 politics, and he served as president of Austin LULAC Council 650 and 21 the South Austin Mexican American Democrats; in addition, he 22 graciously gave of his time and talents as an officer of the Capital 23 Metro Board, the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, and the River City 24 Youth Foundation; and
