R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Carol Adams received the 2003 Volunteer of the Year
2 award on February 7, 2004, from the Katy Area Chamber of Commerce
3 for her outstanding achievements as president of the Katy Heritage
4 Society (KHS); and

5 WHEREAS, Founded in 1979, the KHS is committed to preserving
6 the rich history of the city that was once known as Cane Island;
7 under the sure leadership of Ms. Adams, the organization succeeded
8 in the summer of 2003 in relocating three historic homes, including
9 one that Ms. Adams acquired while negotiating the move, and the old
10 Katy post office to a site adjacent to the Katy Heritage Museum;
11 revenue from the sale of the land on which these structures
12 originally stood is being used to help restore the buildings; and

13 WHEREAS, The relocation of the KHS properties, accomplished
14 in concert with the City of Katy, marks a major step in the
15 development of the new Katy Heritage Park, a historical area that
16 will be tremendously rewarding for residents and tourists alike;

18 WHEREAS, Active in other civic organizations, Ms. Adams is
19 also president of the Katy Literary Society and is a valued member
20 of the Friends of the Katy Library; and

21 WHEREAS, Through her unflagging dedication and remarkable
22 vision, this enterprising citizen of Katy has been instrumental in
23 launching a new era for the Katy Heritage Society, and her efforts
24 have ensured that a significant part of Katy's past will be

1 preserved for the benefit of present and future generations; now,
2 therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
4 Legislature, 4th Called Session, hereby pay tribute to Carol Adams
5 on the occasion of her receipt of the 2003 Volunteer of the Year
6 Award from the Katy Area Chamber of Commerce and extend to her
7 sincere appreciation for her exceptional leadership as president of
8 the Katy Heritage Society; and, be it further
