1           WHEREAS, The Katy High School Tigers football team staged a  
2 dramatic come-from-behind 16-15 victory over the Southlake Carroll  
3 Dragons at the Alamodome to win the 2003 UIL Class 5A Division II  
4 state championship; and

5           WHEREAS, Although the Tigers lost their season opener in  
6 Lufkin, these determined athletes showed themselves to be true  
7 champions by barreling undefeated through the next 15 games,  
8 claiming district, area, and regional championships along the way  
9 to the state crown; and

10           WHEREAS, Head coach Mike Johnston, who was ably supported by  
11 an outstanding staff of assistant coaches and athletic personnel,  
12 picked up his 200th career victory when the Katy Tigers rallied from  
13 a 15-9 deficit in the final three minutes of the game, driving more  
14 than 70 yards to score a touchdown and claim the state championship;

16           WHEREAS, The Tigers have established an enviable tradition of  
17 gridiron excellence by winning their third state championship in  
18 the past seven years, and the achievement of this remarkable feat  
19 required all of the team's talented athletes to perform to the best  
20 of their abilities; this triumph is an apt reflection of their  
21 dedication and competitive spirit and is a most fitting reward for  
22 their many hours of hard work and training; and

23           WHEREAS, The young champions of the Katy High School football  
24 team have indeed distinguished themselves as formidable

1 competitors, and they are a source of tremendous pride to the  
2 students, staff, and faculty of their school and to their many  
3 supporters in the community; now, therefore, be it
